

E-3 Grant Funding Report 2008

The purpose of PPAG E-3 Opportunity Grants (Enhanced Education and Economic Opportunity) is to stimulate educational and promotional opportunities for member organizations of PPAG. E-3 Opportunity Grants require no matching funds and may be requested up to \$500. Total available E-3 Opportunity Grant funding is subject to annual appropriation. (See attached E-3 Grant Application)

In 2008, \$5000 was allocated for E-3 Grant distribution. PPAG received 15 grant applications, 12 Grants were approved and 11 Grants were awarded for a total of \$4900 in funding to PPAG Member Organizations. Those grants not approved either did not fit the grant stipulations or allocated funds had been dispersed.
